



Bike Repair Station Grant Application & Memorandum of Understanding

Go Redmond grants are available to assist businesses and multifamily housing units install [bicycle repair stations](#). Repair stations can be placed in parking garage or area near bike parking for easy access by employees and visitors and should not protrude into a bike lane, walkway, or other common area.

There is no financial risk to the property owner or manager to participate. The City is acting solely as a funding agency and will cover the cost of the installation of bike repair stations. The City is not the vendor of the bicycle repair station and assumes no responsibility whatsoever for the same. The City makes no representations or warranties regarding the repair stations and any such warranties or representations are the sole responsibility of the vendor. Employers are responsible maintenance of the repair stations going forward. Additional grant resources are available from Go Redmond to cover these costs.



THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2017 between the City of Redmond (hereinafter referred to as the "City") and the legal entity as shown above (hereinafter referred to as the "Applicant"), each of which entity may be referred to as "Party" or collectively as the "Parties".

Project Description: Purchase & install Bicycle Repair Stand at the Applicant address.



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I. Project Budget: City will purchase the bicycle repair station and pay for the installation. No employer match is required.

II. Indemnity:

Each Party shall protect, defend, indemnify and save harmless the other Parties, their elected officials, officers, employees, and agents, from any and all costs, claims, judgments, and/or awards of damages, arising out of or in any way resulting from each Party's own negligent acts or omissions in performing work under this Agreement. Each Party agrees that it is fully responsible for the acts and omissions of its own subcontractors, and their employees and agents, acting within the scope of their employment as such, as it is for the acts and omissions of its own employees and agents. Each Party agrees that its obligations under this provision extend to any claim, demand, and/or cause of action brought by or on behalf of any of its employees or agents. The foregoing indemnity is specifically and expressly intended to constitute a waiver of each Party's immunity under Washington's Industrial Insurance Act, RCW Title 51, as respects the other Parties only, and only to the extent necessary to provide the indemnified Parties with a full and complete indemnity of claims made by the indemnitor's employees. The Parties acknowledge that these provisions were specifically negotiated and agreed upon by them.
