






Regional Map

Trail Etiquette

- Stay to the right
- Pass on the left
- Give audible signal when passing
- 15 mph speed limit
- Yield (bikes to peds to horses to bikes)
- Groups & pets shouldn't take up more than 1/2 of the trail

Bike Tips


- Always wear a helmet
- Lock up your wheel & frame
- Be visible! Wear bright colors and lights
- Align your bike with a loop to change a light
- "Sharrows" - slow you where you're supposed to ride
- Always ride with the flow of traffic

Bus Tips

- Store your gear, not on the seat next to you
- Request your stop, pull the cord
- Find your seat. Leave front seats open for exact change or ORCA card and those with disabilities
- When in doubt, ask your driver for help
- Have fare ready to exact change or ORCA card
- Click your ORCA card on the reader with your group

Find Transportation Options, Earn Rewards

Receive a free 1-month ORCA bus pass, get information on starting a bike commute, help matching with carpools and vanpools in your neighborhood, and earn rewards when you don't drive alone.

Plan Your Trip

To find the best bus route, visit the Metro Trip Planner. Enter your travel time, origin, and destination to get easy to follow directions and trip options.

The OneBusAway.org website and app provides real-time transit information to find out when your bus arrives.

Get a Transit Pass

The One Regional Card for All (ORCA) card allows you pay for fares and make transfers on King County Metro, Sound Transit, and other regional provider's bus and light rail trips. Load monthly passes, individual "e-purse" fares, youth, senior, and low income fares for transit (LIFT) on your ORCA card.
